<div>(II b).</div> <div>The 3200 Years of Nabonidos.</div> <div>From Naram-sin, the traditional son of Sargon of Akkad, to the reign of Nabonidos</div>	
Nabonidos, like Sargon II of Asyria, as column to the right - omitted 20.5 years of the 1st 10 kings of Dynasty IX of the Lists, thus ignoring this period for the aramaic Supremacy.	
The reign of Nabonidos began at B.c. 533 = 3446.5 A.K. (Table XXI).	
By the deduction of 201.5 years, Nabonidos reckoned his reign as beginning at 3245 A.K. He states that Naram-sin the alleged son of Sargon of Akkad, - the legendary founder of Babylonia - reigned 3200 years before his own time. This gives us a reckoning from 0 A.K. to 45 A.K. For the reign of Sargon. The King List actually gives Sargon's reign as 55 years. The mythological chronology system of the time of Nabonidos, therefore, began Sargon of Akkad at 0 A.K.	
Sennacherib and Assurbanipal therefore omitteddd Dynasties VI-VIII and the 1st 10 kings of Dynasty IX (totalling 249.25 years); thus hiding the fact of the long period of Aramaic Supremacy in Assyria.	

<div>(III a).</div> <div>Sargon's "Lunar Period"</div> <div>and the fictitiousbasis of its Chronological placing as prior to Sargon's Accession.</div>				
Sargon of Assyria, in his Annals(II-35),, refers to a "lunar period" from "the most remote times" being renewed at the beginning of his reign. This is explained asfollows: -
